Project



In 2010, the Rio de Janeiro chapter began an educational project in the *favela* districts served by Pacifying Police Units (UPP), a local state government safety enhancement program. Our goal was to support the pacification process by promoting Vocational Education and thereby aid the economic development of such areas.



What we do



The program targets creating employment and income (both formal and from entrepreneurship) with two main goals:

- ✓ Vocational qualification and certification for young people at risk.
- ✓ Retraining workers, unemployed or not, providing vocational certification to increase their chances in the job market.

People served



Up to May 2013, **3,300** residents had been qualified and certified in **14 pacified districts**. By the end of **2014** we will have reached **another 3,000 professionals**.


